**Immunizations:** If your student receives any immunizations during the school year, please turn in the documentation including the dates to the health office so they can be recorded. It helps keep our records up-to-date for when we complete our immunization report for the state.

**ATTENTION 7th Grade Students:** Current 7th grade needed to receive their Tdap and Meningitis vaccinations to start the school year unless they have a doctor signed medical exemption or notarized conscientious objection. Please check ParentVUE to see if your student is compliant. ***This needs to be completed by October 12, 2021 or your student will be sent home from school.***

**Illness Guidelines:** If your student is experiencing any signs/symptoms of possible infectious illness, (runny/stuffy nose, cough, sore throat, fever, etc.) please keep them home. 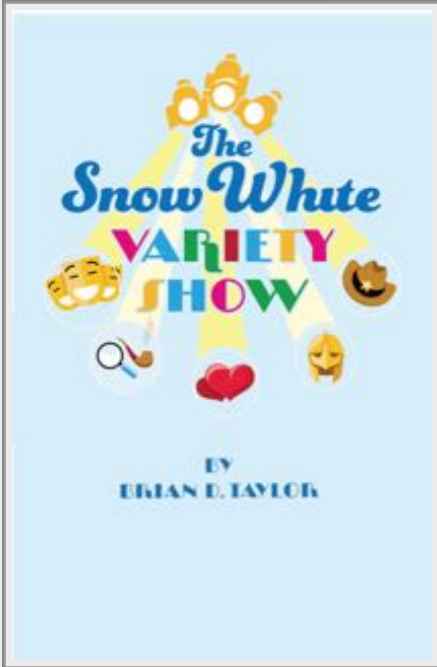
