 - Mental Health- Jessica stated that SCPA has received funding for social/emotional assistance to students
 - There may be funding available for 24/25 SY for a calming space/area
 - School counselors are working with PE teachers to incorporate mental health into their curriculum
 - Encourage outlets for students on how to express their emotions (journaling, art, music, PE) how to be creative and present
