IF your student is leaving early, parent must complete Attendance Reporting Form (<u>link here</u>) online detailing the student's early dismissal and the reason. The student will sign out at the designated time with the Main Office and will leave through the main entrance (Door 1). They will either meet their parent outside after they have signed out or they will drive themselves.

Communication Process with Faculty: The communication procedure for issues with teachers is as follows:

Synergy/SchoolPay: St. Croix Prep utilizes Synergy as its Student Information System. ParentVUE, within this system, allows a parent to view attendance, homework, grades, and much more.
