

- bus(ses) and driver(s)
- Step-on Guide for each bus



## Hotel

- Typically either in D.C. or right outside of D.C.
  - Examples: Crystal City; Pentagon City
- Night guards on duty
- Typically 4 students per room
- Hotel rules
  - Can't wander around
  - Need to stay in assigned room
  - Chaperones will check rooms each night
  - Tape on door
  - Report from night guards each morning
- Students will fill out roommate request form in the spring
