Attendance/Student Absences: For student absences and late school day arrivals, please call this number, 651-395-5992, by 9:00am or record your student's absences electronically via ParentVUE. Log into ParentVUE and select 'Record Absence' next to your child's name to begin the process. School staff will review entries daily as soon as possible. If you are picking up your student early from school, please include the pick up time in the note area and our staff will send a pass to your student so they are ready to be picked up when you arrive. Parents *must* walk your student(s) into the main office and sign in for late arrivals. A parent or approved guardian *must* come into the Main Office to sign out their Middle School student(s).

Homework Expectations: SCPA curriculum is an academically rigorous and content rich language-based program. Homework is important and must be done on time. Late daily assignments receive zero credit. When completing assignments for any SCPA class, you will be expected to turn in your best-quality work. A student may be placed on Academic Probation for the Quarter if they receive a D or an F in one or more quarters in a core class. Core classes include Math, Social Studies, Science, Language Arts, Reading and, Logic/Latin. If a student receives two or more D's or F's as Quarter grades, in two or more core classes, he or she will be required to repeat the grade level.
